

Richland County Youth and Family Council Kinship Care Closet

The Richland County Youth and Family Council Kinship Care Closet will be used to support Richland County Kinship providers in an effort to help eliminate any barriers involved with the transition of a youth from one placement to another. The intent with the RCYFC Kinship Care Closet is to create and/or maintain a safe household for youth 0-21. This is emergent and ongoing support that is available to Richland County youth provided by Richland County Youth and Family Council.

Some of the Items offered in the Kinship Care Closet (this list is not exhaustive and some other items can be purchased as needed):

Diapers Wipes **Nightlights** Sheets/bedding (all sizes toddler-twin) Diaper rash cream Shampoo Conditioner Lotion Toothpaste/Toothbrush Towels Hair care/brushes Lice care products Washcloths Bibs Bottle/accessories **Outlet plugs** Safety latches Clothing 0-21 Sippy cups Toddler utensils Thermometers **Travel Changing pads** Carseats Highchairs Safety gates Comfort items Books Puzzles Pack and Plays

Making the choice to be a kinship provider is only the beginning. Bringing a child in to your home can be costly. The Kinship Care closet is designed to help eliminate some of the financial stress so the transition can run more smoothly, and the child can stay with his/her family. While different children require different items, there are a few must have items before a child can safely be in the home.

Bedding: The Care closet has a variety of bedding items. Pack and plays, sheets, blankets, waterproof pads, etc.

Personal hygiene items: The Care Closet has the basics on hand. Having the correct personal care items age appropriate for each child can make all the difference when it comes to feeling comfortable in their new home.

Comfort items/transition items: A brand-new comfort item can help ease the transition from a prior placement to a new home. A comfortable blanket can make all the difference. Children of all ages may enjoy a new stuffed animal. Easy to carry bags will also make the transition a little easier. Books/puzzles are available.

Clothes: The Care Closet offers a variety of clothing in different sizes.

Besides having a comfortable place to sleep, the most important things are that the child receives the patience and loving care needed for a happy and healthy childhood. The Richland County Youth and Family Council Kinship Care Closet is designed to help have items prepared ahead of time to help ease the transition and to also be a support for emergent, as needed situations when they arise.
